

Questions to Clarify Your Call

What is the last issue that made me righteously angry or brought me to tears?

What or who would I go to jail for if need arose?

What or who am I willing to die for?

What /Who am I willing to be inconvenienced for day in and day out?

What do I talk about the most?

What legacy do I want to leave?

What do I want said about me at my funeral- or written in my obituary- or on my tombstone?

If I were guaranteed success, had unlimited funds, and solid support, what would I want to attempt for the kingdom of God?

What repeating patterns, words, or themes do I see God creating as my personal path to live out my passionate calling for His Kingdom?
